



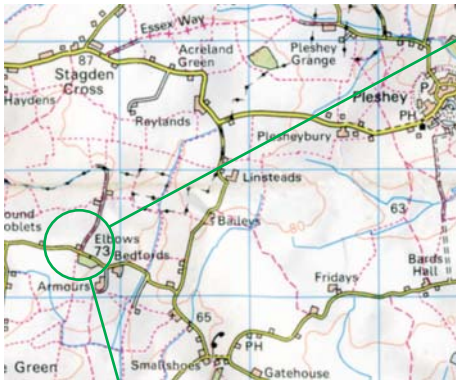
Good Easter and Clatterford End Walk

March 16th 2008. Start 12.30 (Map ref 638133)

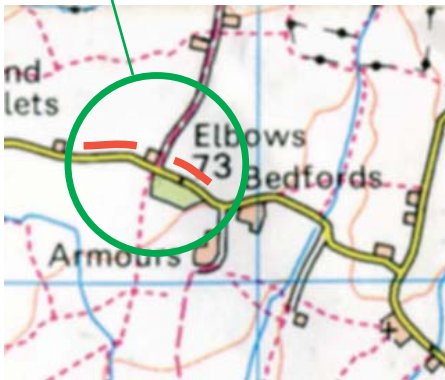
5.5 miles. About 3 hours

Park on the northside verge of Bedfords Road, either side of a house called 'Beulah'. The walk is mainly on footpaths, but does feature short stretches of road. It does incorporate some paths previously walked, but much is new. Muddy when wet.

Getting there



From either Chelmsford or Pleshey, turn down the road which is signed as below.



Follow the pointer for Good Easter/The Rodings. The road is additionally marked by the helpful Bedfords Hill street sign.

Park on the verges in the areas marked in red on the map to the left.

As stated, the going is muddy when wet. Also, some sections of the walk are exposed, so be prepared for brisk winds.
